## About the Role

- Support the Asset Management teams during monthly financial reporting, quarterly valuations, financial analyses, end-of-year budget and strategy preparation, forecasting/modeling, and day-to-day operations of existing portfolio

The Summer 2024 internship will be located in-person at Virtus' corporate office in Austin, TX. The full-time internship will start in June 2024, with the option for part-time availability beginning in January 2024.
